o Satisfactory level of library services

- + had experienced and well- satisfied (26)
- - Claims from membership fee (1), not enough facilities (2), bad librarian's attitute (2), too crowded to study (1)

o Overall point of view about library

- ☑ Can promote reading habit & educate users (7),
- ☑ Have heterogeneous users of the community(5),
- ☑ Can lead to information awareness (1),

o Public Library role:

- Female (28): raise community information awareness, promote reading, help knowledge sharing, help to better services at school and academic libraries, provide services to children and the seniors and special needed users, use as place to study
- Male (10): Think Public libraries are public universities (5), Can complete eduational procedure of community (3), information awareness and promote reading (2), use as a place to study, reading and research
