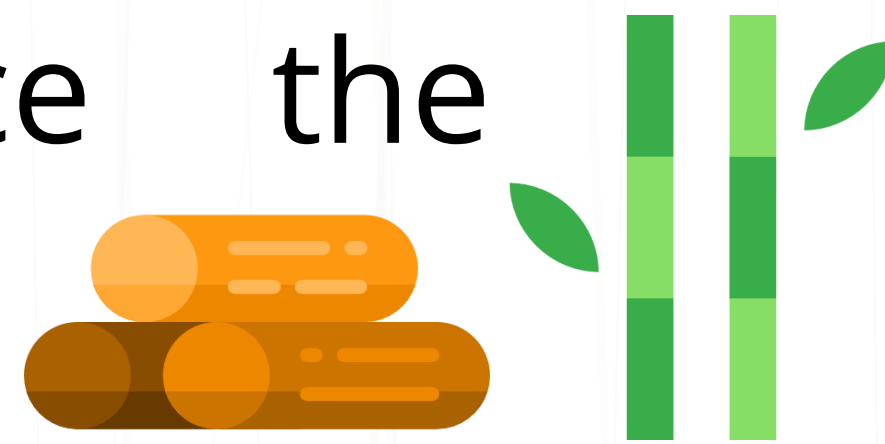


WHAT IS A GREEN LIBRARY?

It was built or renovated with natural/renewable material to reduce the ecological footprint.

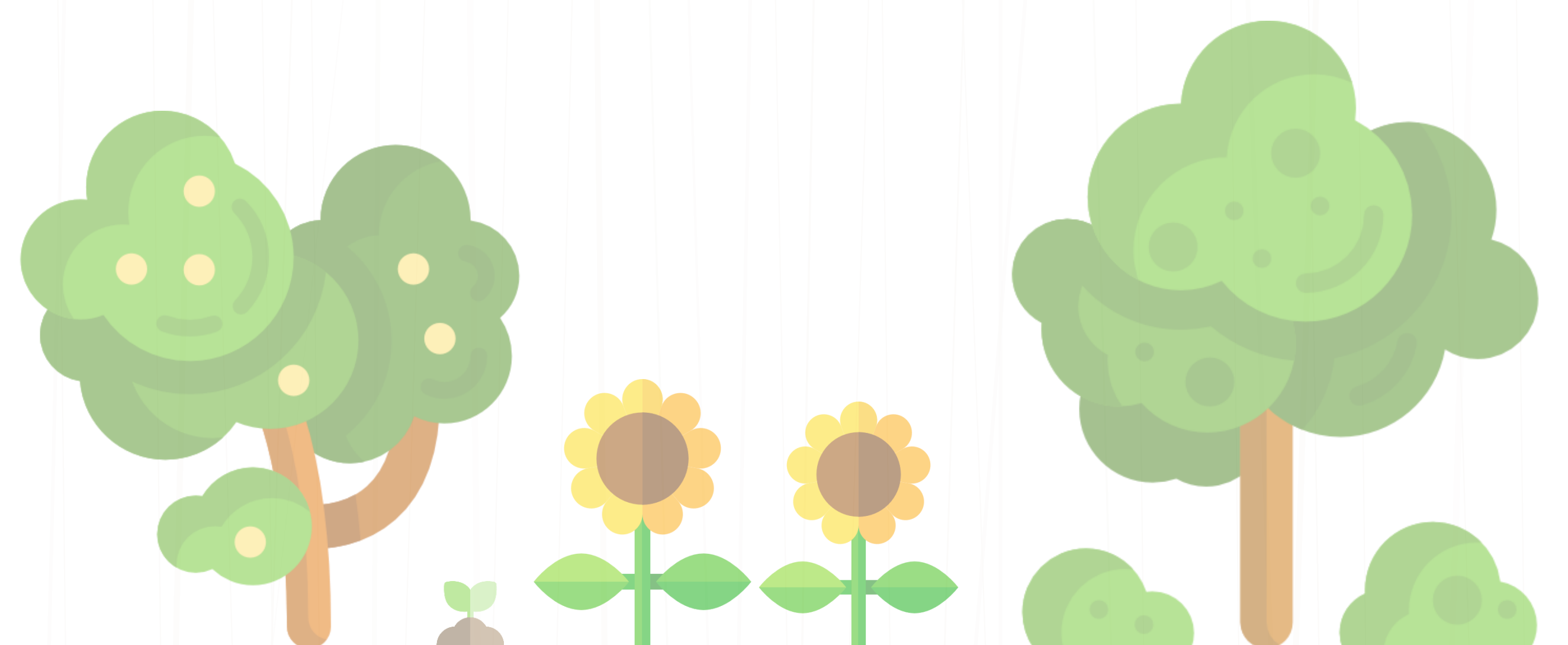
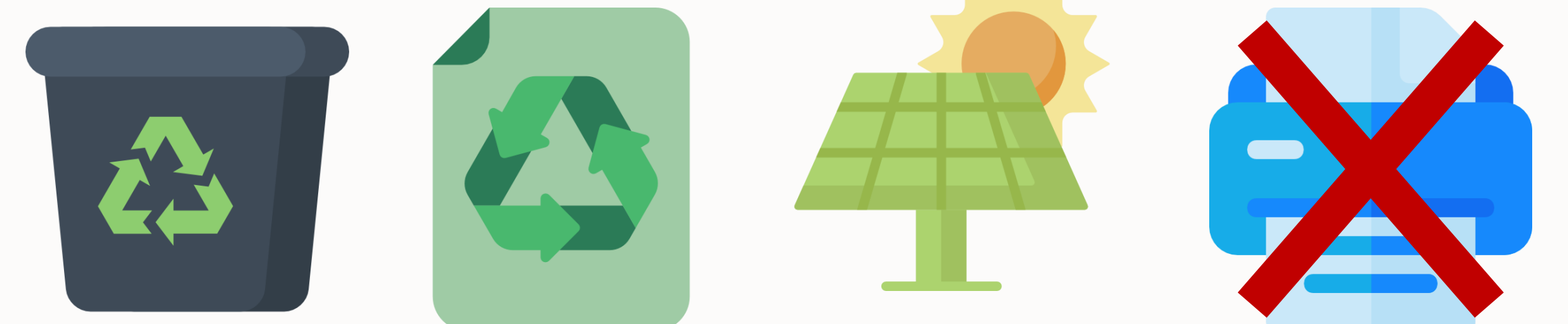


Readings, events or workshops raise awareness of the ecological and social transformation of the society.
