Abstract

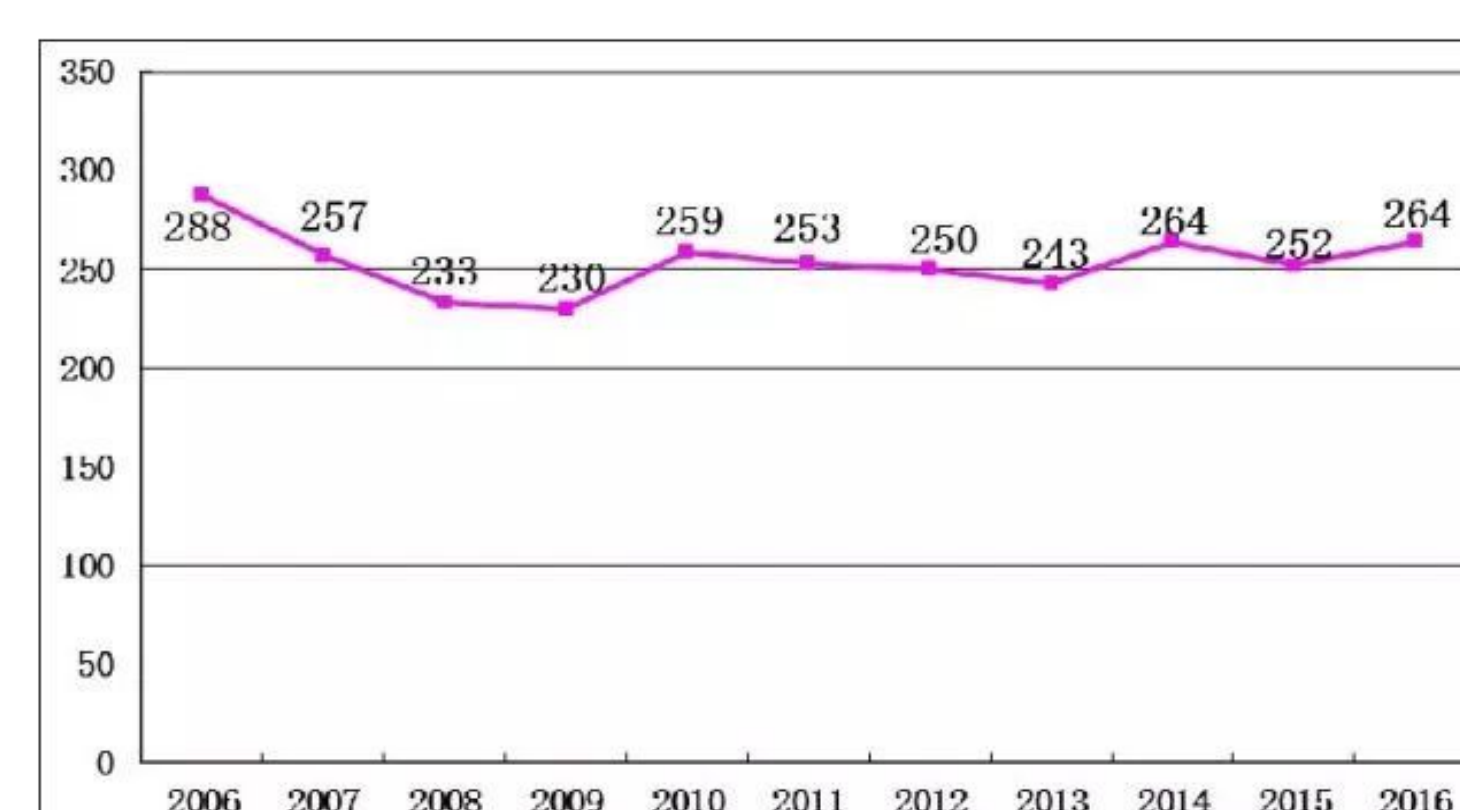


Figure 1. Average University Libraries Print Materials Expenditures 2006-2016

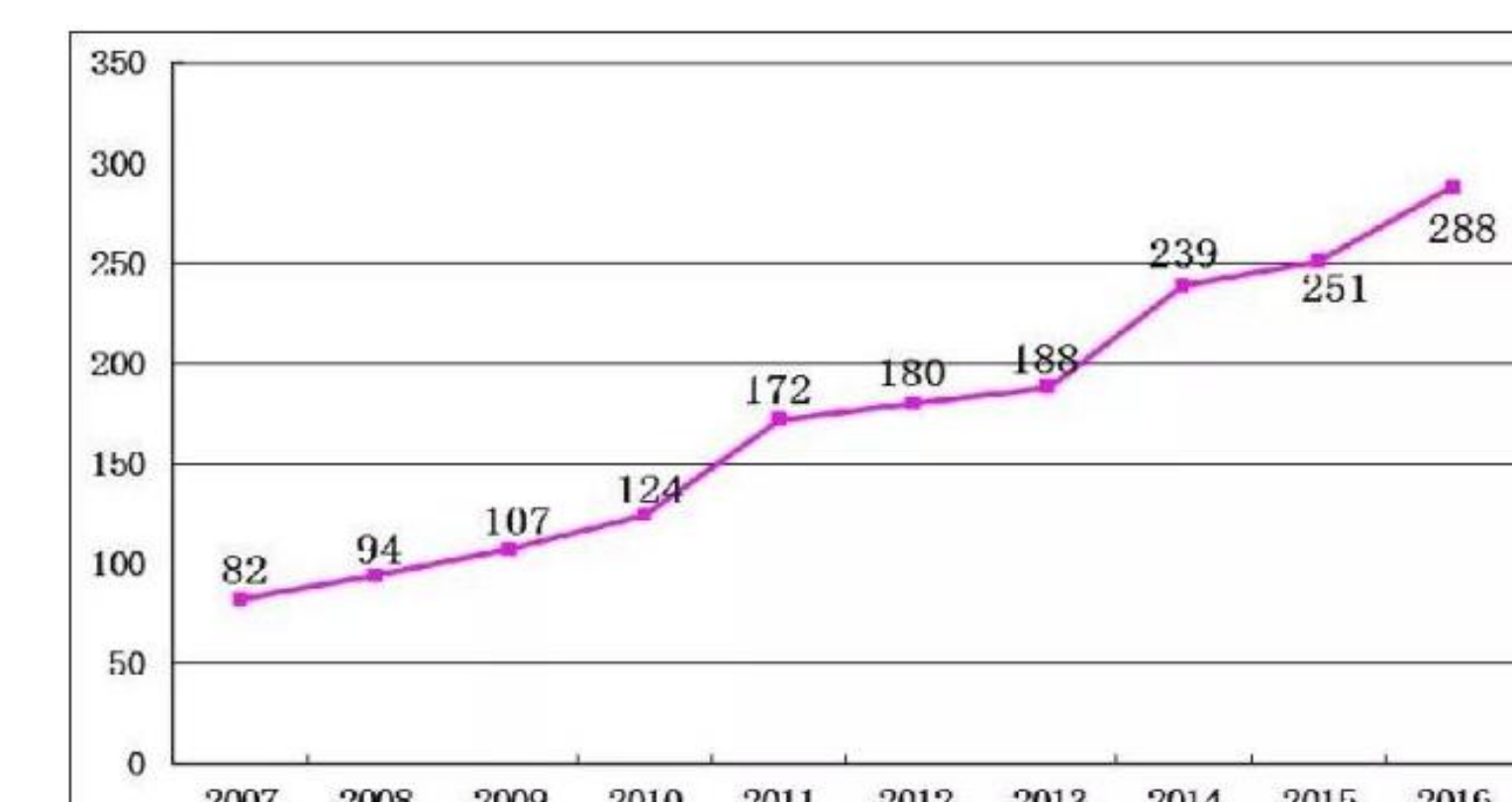


Figure 2. Average University Libraries Electronic Materials Expenditures 2006-2016

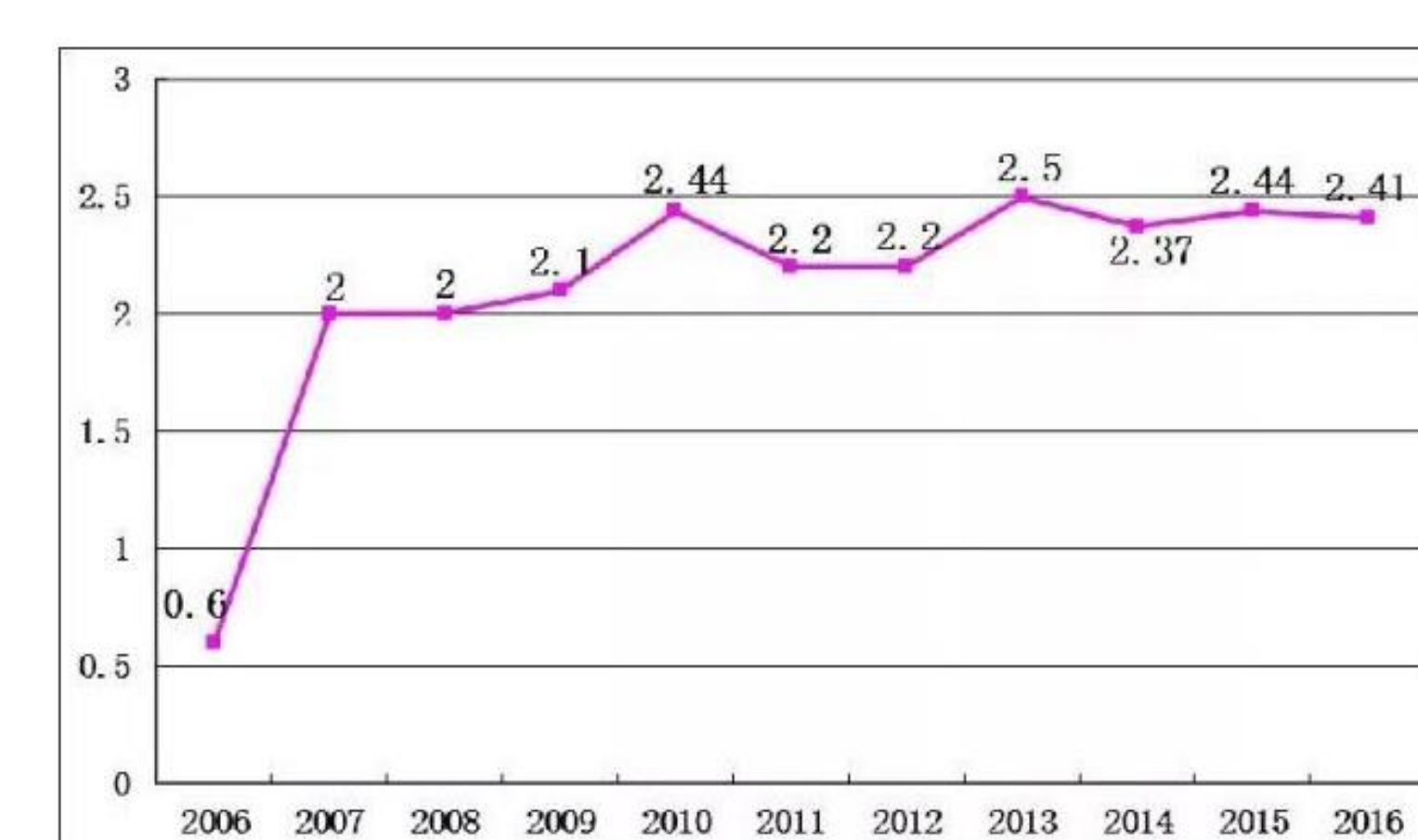


Figure 4. Average Size of New University Library Buildings (Square Meters) 2006-2016
